



**Volunteer Position: Physician**

**Location:** Malta House of Care Mobile Health Clinics (MHC)

Wednesday: 12:00-5:00pm at St Peter's Church

**Duties:**

Core privileges as a primary care provider: include medical treatment of patients, the physical examinations, the ordering and preliminary interpretation of diagnostic studies including laboratory, diagnostic imaging, and electrocardiograph examinations.

*There is a large prevalence of chronic untreated Diabetes and HTN present in our patient population!*

Green Track provider coverage: Interpretation of diagnostic studies and appropriate refills of current medications based on those studies.

Van provider coverage: Performance of complete physical exams as required, i.e., any new patients, school/employment PE.

Continuing "hands on" management of chronic conditions which exceeds refills of medications only.

Must be able to document findings in electronic medical records (training provided).

**Qualifications:**

- ♦ Basic education M.D./O.D.
- ♦ Must have a current CT medical license, DEA, CTCS licenses without restrictions.
- ♦ Current skills in primary care medicine
- ♦ Able to correctly access patient and develop a plan of care based on best practice guidelines per medical director.
- ♦ Documentation of current Flu vaccine
- ♦ Yearly PPD testing

**Credentialing process:** Malta House of Care requires all Physicians and Nursing volunteers to submit to a background and National Data Bank check prior to applying for malpractice coverage through the Federal Tort Claims Act (FTCA). This process may take up to 8 weeks to complete entitling an individual to actively volunteer.
